Contracting Tools

UMass Donahue Institute is a pre-approved vendor on a number of procurement tools at both the federal and state levels. In many cases we are able to simplify the contracting process for eligible clients, minimizing or eliminating the need for a time-consuming, burdensome bid process. Examples of contracting instruments we use include:

Federal

General Services Administration (GSA)



We are approved as a vendor on the GSA Professional Services Schedule (PSS). This allows us to offer Integrated Consulting Services and Training Services to federal clients
